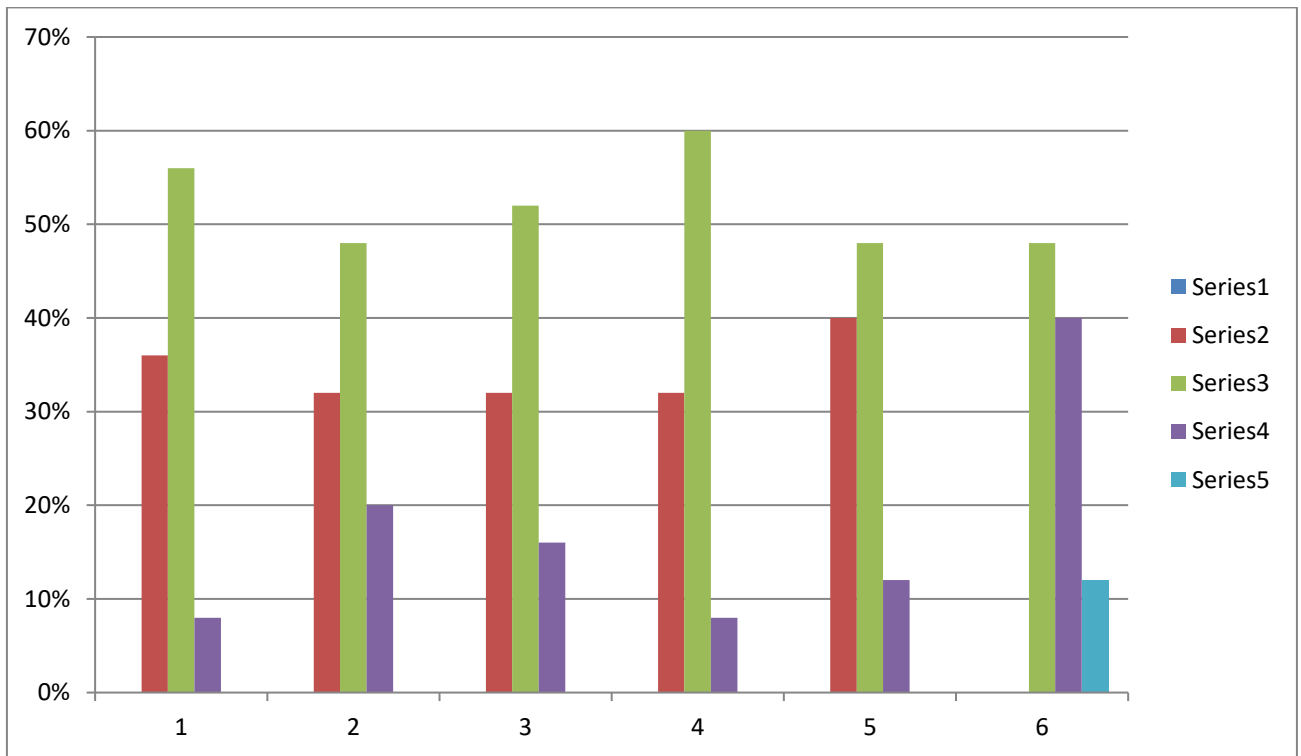

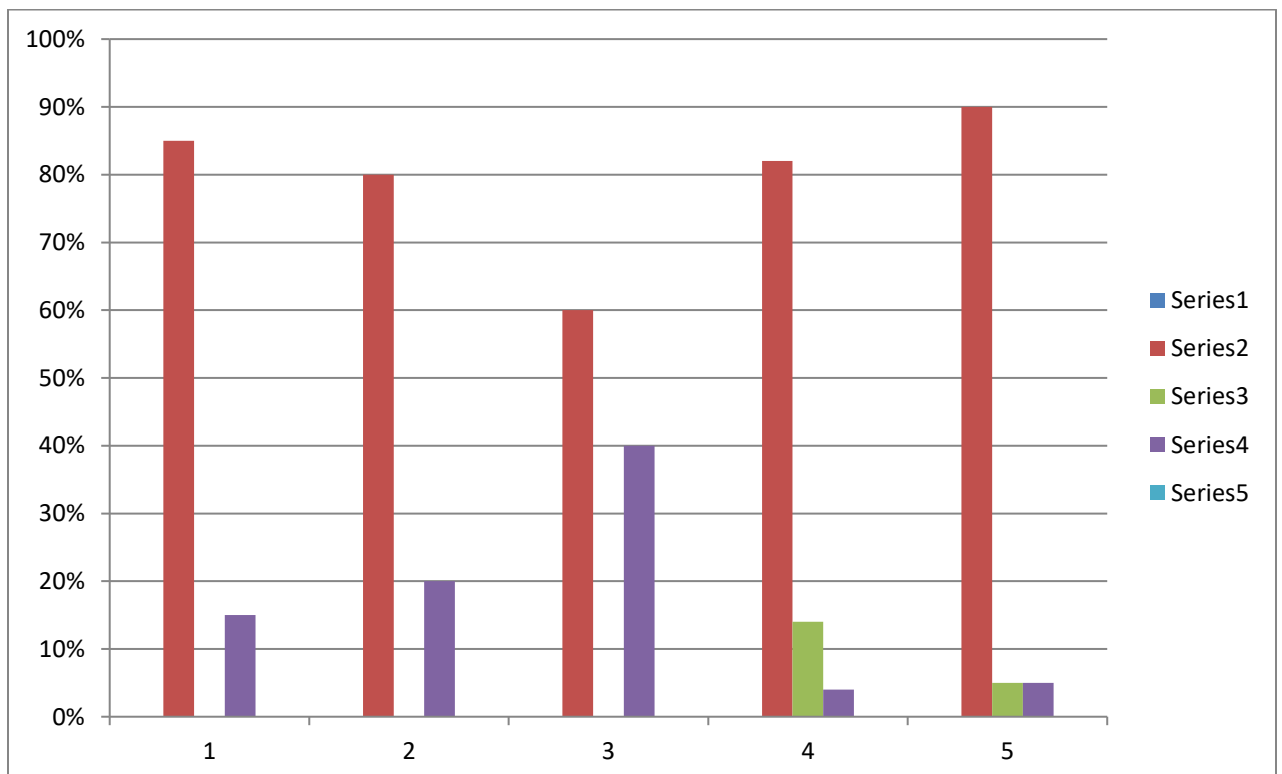

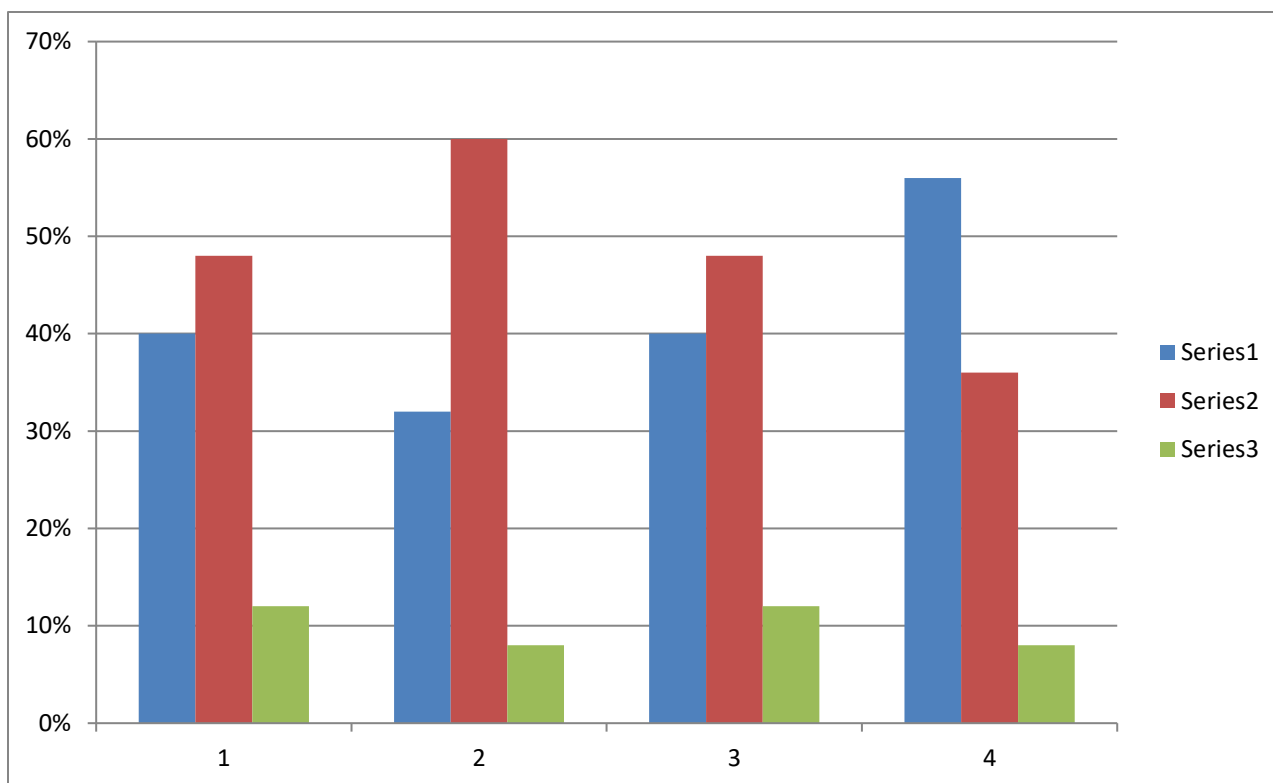

Stakeholders Feedback Collection and Analysis Report of 2017-18

Collection of Feedback

Feedback on curriculum and related aspects has been collected off line through questioner by IQAC. Feedbacks have been designed separately for students, teachers and parents. Collected and analysis is made every year.

From March, the feedbacks made available for a stakeholders and analyses made by IQAC with the assistance of Department of Mathematics in the month of April, 2018. Major suggestions from stakeholders were forwarded to concerned Departments for Action.

During the Academic year 2017 – 18, 94 students from 6 UG programmes and 3 PG programmes gave their feedback on curriculum and academic environment and other student related services on campus.

1. Student feedback Analysis:

Questionnaire for students is structured with six questions on curriculum. The questions in all these cases are to be answered on 5 rating scale beginning poor to excellent and one open question for suggestions.

Curriculum based Question:

1. Relevance of overall Course Structure of the curriculum
36% of the students are of the opinion that the overall structure of the Curriculum is very good and 56% of the students are of the opinion that the overall structure of the Curriculum is good.
2. Scope for the skill development in the Course offered
32% of the student's opinion is that the skill development is very good and 52% of the students are of the opinion that skill development offered in the course is good Balance
3. Balance with regard to theoretical and practical knowledge in the curriculum
32% of the students are of the opinion that balance between theoretical and practical knowledge is very good and 52% of the students are of the opinion that balance between theoretical and practical knowledge is good.
4. Use of teaching aids and ICT in the classroom to facilitate teaching
32% & 60% of the students expressed their opinion that the Use of teaching Aids & ICT in the class room to facilitate teaching is very good & good.
5. Extent of syllabi covered in the classroom
88% (40% +48%) of the students are of the students are of the opinion that the coverage of the syllabus is very good and good.
6. Experience with evaluation process
48% of the students are of the opinion that the Experience with evaluation process is good.
52% (40% + 12%) of the students are of the opinion that the experience with evaluation process is average & below average.

Suggestions from the Students

- 1) Internal assessment should be included in the curriculum.
- 2) Elective papers in some specialized areas in the respective courses need to be introduced in the Curriculum.
- 3) Contents of the syllabus have to be written very clearly and specifically in some of the courses.
- 4) Necessary steps have to be taken for the Timely announcement of the result and timely availability of the marks sheets as they are losing one complete Academic year for their admission into higher studies.
- 5) Library facilities, Internet facilities, drinking water /wash room facilities, sports/gym facilities need improvement.
- 6) Students also suggested that there should be a regular Librarian & a Physical Director in this Institution.
- 7) The students also wish to have canteen facility and College Bus facility for the students coming from a distance 10 km and above.

- 8) Some of the students are of the opinion that they wish to have M.Sc Chemistry & M.Sc Zoology Courses in this College.

All these suggestions were forwarded to the Principal for necessary action.

2. Teacher's Feedback:

Questionnaire for teachers is structured with five questions on curriculum. The questions in all these cases are to be answered on 5-point Likert scale for agreement and one open question for suggestions.

1. The course content is relevant to the course / Programme
85% of the faculty agreed that Course content is relevant to the Course/ Programme outcomes.
2. The Curriculum is balanced with regard to the Theoretical & Practical Knowledge
80% of the faculty agreed that the Curriculum designed is balanced with regard to Theoretical & Practical Knowledge.
3. The timely coverage of syllabus is possible in the mentioned number of hours.
60% of the faculty agreed that the timely coverage of syllabus is possible in the mentioned number of hours.
4. The College facilitates and encourages the use of ICT tools for the Teaching – Learning process.
82% of the faculty agreed that College encourages the use of ICT tools for teaching - learning.
5. The present Curriculum motivates the student to pursue career in the core areas of Science/Arts/humanities
90% of the faculty agreed that the present Curriculum motivates the student to pursue career in the core areas of Science/Arts/humanities.

Suggestions from teachers –

- 1) The contents of syllabus in some of the Courses have to be written very clearly and specifically.
- 2) Additional class rooms should be provided with the required Infrastructure for ICT & with Wi- Fi facility.
- 3) Research activities for the College faculty should not be insisted upon for those handling UG classes.
- 4) The number of hours & the number of credits allotted in some of the courses should be mentioned very clearly for the completion of the syllabus on time.
- 5) Many faculties are of the opinion that the previous Curriculum is far better than the CBCS.
- 6) In the existing CBCS Curriculum, in the B.Sc Chemistry Programme, the practicals syllabus is not properly organized and the reference books mentioned in some of the Courses are irrelevant. The above suggestions were communicated to the Principal for necessary action.

3. Parent Feedback Analysis:

This questionnaire is structured with three questions. All the four questions are to be answered either three graded scale with suggestions. 36 parents have given their feedback on line during the academic year 2017-18.

1. Is the content and design of the curriculum satisfactory?
88% (45% + 46%) of the parents are of the opinion that the Contents and design of the Curriculum is very good and good.
2. Employment opportunities /admission into higher studies after the course completion is
92% (32% + 60%) of the parents are of the opinion that Employment opportunities /admission into higher studies after the course completion is very good and good.
3. Does the curriculum ensure all-round development of ward?
88% (40% + 48%) of the parents are of the opinion that the Overall development of the ward is very good & good.
4. Quality of teaching available in the College is
92% (56% and 36%) of the parents expressed their opinion Very good and good about the Quality of Teaching offered by the College

Suggestions from Parents -

- 1) Parents have requested that as they are financially poor, all the prescribed textbooks should be given to the students by the Government.
- 2) Transport facility should be provided by the College for the students coming from a distance of 10 Km and above.
- 3) The parents have requested to make arrangements for the Campus Placements to their wards.
- 4) Parents have expressed their opinion to Start M.Sc Chemistry Course & M.Sc Zoology Course in this College from the next Academic year.

The suggestions were communicated to the Principal for necessary action.
